## HOW TO USE THIS DIRECTORY TO LOCATE A GRAVE

1. In alphabetical list, find the name.
2. In the right hand column, the left hand letter indicates which cemetery is involved. The number is the lot number shown on the lot layout. The letter on the right indicates the part of the lot occupied (East or West).
3. Layouts are supplied for the two largest cemeteries, Pine Grove and McCoy. (Pages vi and vii). Lot numbers are shown for Pine Grove - all others indicate row and stone.

Key to cross references. Letters stand for cemeteries, numbers for row and stone except Pine Grove, which are lot numbers.



# RULES OF THE PINE GROVE AND MCCOY CEMETERIES

## GILFORD, NEW HAMPSHIRE

1. Gates will be closed anytime the superintendent deems necessary.
2. Persons with firearms will not be permitted in or about the cemetery grounds, except when participating at a military funeral or for Memorial Day exercises.
3. Children must be accompanied within the cemetery grounds by someone responsible for their conduct. Pine Grove and McCoy Cemeteries will not be held responsible for any damages caused by children to memorials or plants, as the cemetery grounds are not a place for children to play.
4. The sales of lots are restricted to residents and taxpayers of Gilford. Arrangements for the purchase of a lot or grave must be made with the secretary-treasurer of the cemetery and shall be sold at prices fixed by the directors of the Pine Grove & McCoy Cemeteries. All lots will be sold with perpetual care, and this amount will be included with the purchase price of the lot. Lot owners may resell or transfer their interest in their lot or graves by endorsing the back of their lot certificate and returning it to the treasurer of the cemetery for the proper change in the cemetery records. A new certificate will be issued in the name of the new lot owner or owners. No lot will change ownership unless the change has been recorded with the treasurer of the Pine Grove and McCoy Cemeteries. Grave lots may be sold back to the cemetery at the original price of the lot, however, the trust fund/perpetual care portion cannot be refunded.
5. All dogs or any other animals brought onto Pine Grove or McCoy Cemetery property must be on a leash or restrained.
6. Monuments or memorials shall not be set on any cemetery lot without a cement foundation. These foundations must be approved by the superintendent. All grave markers must be set at grass level, unless duplicating an existing marker on the lot. Grass markers may be set without a foundation. Placement must conform to the rules of the cemetery.
7. Only one monument is permitted on a lot, and this cannot occupy over one half the width of the lot. Monuments and stone sizes shall be limited to no more than thirty-six inches from ground level. Monuments on all grave lots will be placed on the east side of said lots except in the case of full 24'x24' lots. In which instance the monument will be placed in the center of said lots. No foundation will be constructed when ground is frozen. Foundations will not be installed if any money is due on the purchase of graves, lots, or parts of lots, charges for the opening or filling graves, or for any other charges due Pine Grove/McCoy Cemeteries. Any markers will not be set if any money is due on grave.

8. The words "perpetual care" shall not be cut on any monument, memorial or marker on any lot in the cemetery, unless a trust fund for the perpetual care of said lot has been established prior to the setting of the monument, memorial, or marker.
9. All workmen, whether stone cutters, setters, helpers, or truckmen, are subject to the direction and control of the superintendent.
10. The regular care of lots consists of mowing and trimming the grass, removing any old flowers, fallen leaves, branches from trees, or any other debris. This does not provide for water, fertilizer, special care of monuments or plants. The regular care of lots with "perpetual care" will be discontinued after each yearly amount of interest on the principal has been expended.
11. The grade of all lots made over and re-seeded will be determined by the superintendent and under his supervision. The grade will be level and grave mounds will not be allowed.
12. All graves shall be opened under the supervision of the superintendent, and the charges shall be set by the sexton with the approval of the directors. Extra charges will be made for graves opened at double depth to allow for the burial of two persons in one grave. Cement vaults or liners must be used.
13. Disinterment and removal of the body will not be allowed until a written order has been filed with the superintendent giving permission by next of kin of the person whose body is to be removed, together with the consent of the lot owner, or owners. State Law requires a written permit from the State Board of Health. No other interment, other than that of a human being, will be permitted in these cemeteries.
14. The planting of flowers or any other plants, on lots or graves will not be permitted unless permission has been granted by the superintendent. Shrubs, bushes or trees are not permitted. When present shrubs, bushes or trees become too large or interfere with the normal operations of the cemetery, they shall be removed.
15. Not over two (2) cement urns, or one (1) large plant container will be permitted. All flowers, baskets, urns, containers, or plants must be kept near monument. All decorations must be placed out of the way of mowing machines. Plastic flowers must be in a container. Artificial and real flowers, statuary, toys, wooden or glass objects, or other items shall be removed at the discretion of the superintendent, if he determines them to be unsightly or to interfere with proper maintenance of such lots. One week following Memorial Day, single lots will be limited to one (1) item and multiple lots will be limited to three (3). Items in excess thereof shall be removed by the superintendent. At no time will wires be allowed to hold flower containers.

16. Fences, curbing or stone enclosures around a lot will not be permitted. Corner posts must be kept flush with the ground. Shells, toys, wooden or glass objects of any kind, eternal lights, are not permitted on the grounds of the cemetery. The use of bricks, sand, cement, gravel, wires, crushed rock, wood chips or other materials on or about a grave is not allowed, and may be removed by the superintendent without notice.
17. The Pine Grove and McCoy Cemeteries will not be held responsible for any damage to lots, posts, shrubbery, markers or monuments, caused by snowplows or workmen during the winter months; or for the loss or damage to any flowers, plants, or shrubs caused by frost, vandals or any other cause beyond their control. The superintendent has the right to enter upon any lot to remove grass, leaves, branches, or any other offensive or improper objects. New Hampshire State Laws prohibit persons from writing upon, defacing or injuring any monument, marker, or any other structures, in or belonging to the cemetery. The law also prohibits the plucking of any flowers, injuring or breaking any trees, shrubs or plants, or entering upon any individual lot without permission.
18. The directors reserve the right to change the rules or charges whenever a change is deemed necessary. The superintendent is directed to enforce the above rules. Any exceptions must be authorized by the superintendent.
19. The cremation burial area (lane between benches) allows for one full burial or four (4) cremations. Flat markers only are allowed in this area (up to four (4)). Nothing is allowed above ground one week after Memorial Day.

These rules are effective June 15, 1999 and grantees are held subject to and responsible for any changes at future date.
