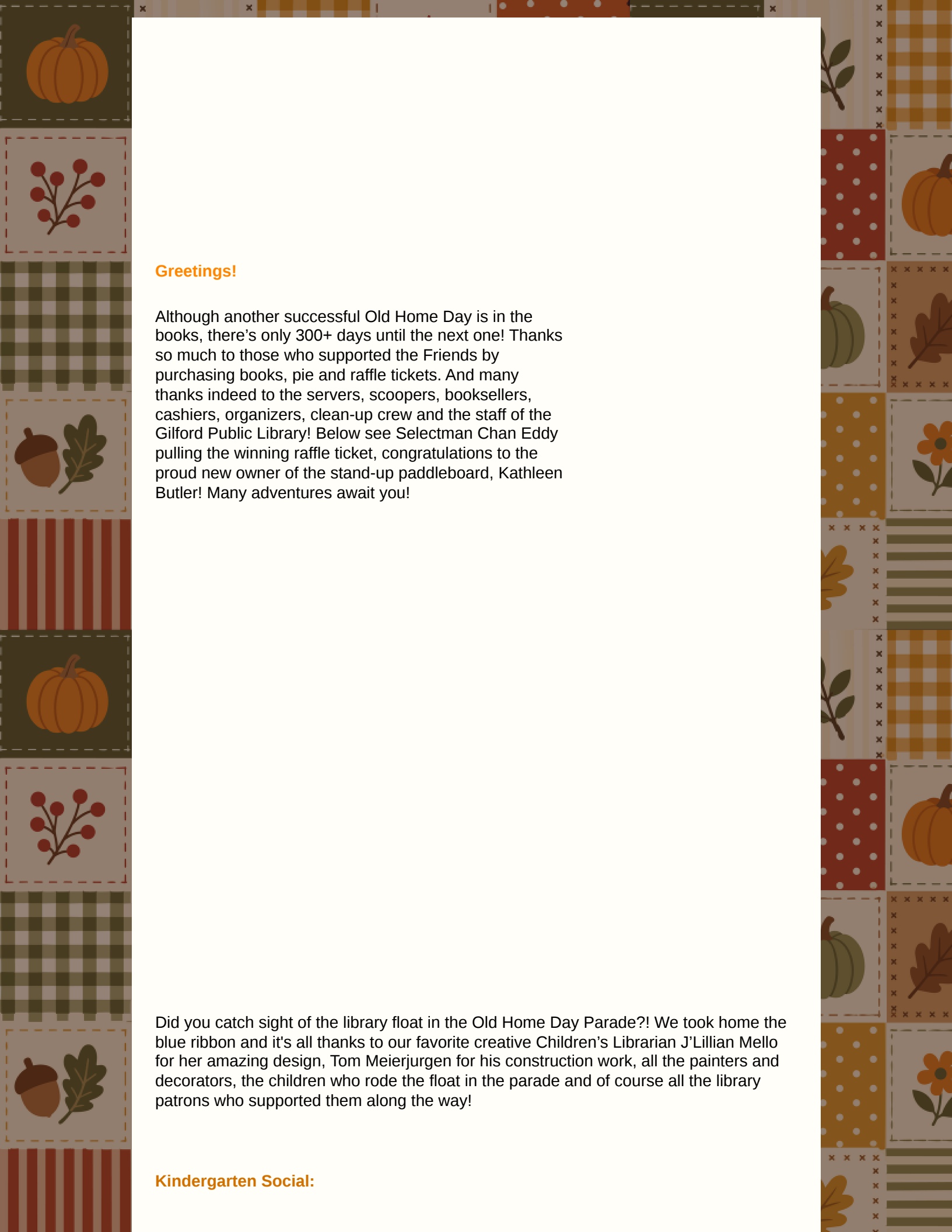


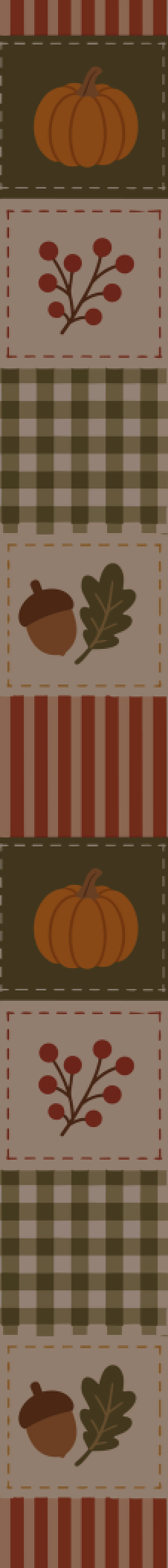


Greetings!

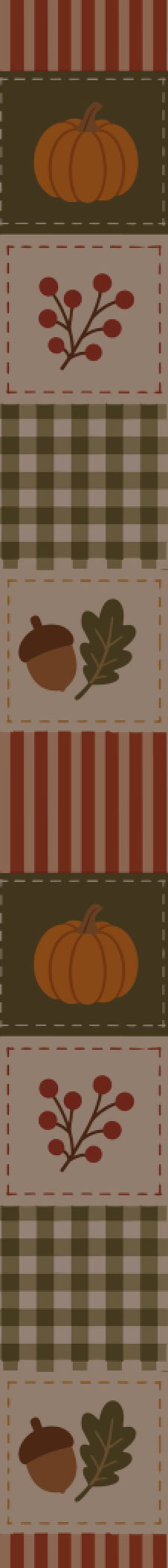

Kindergarten Social:



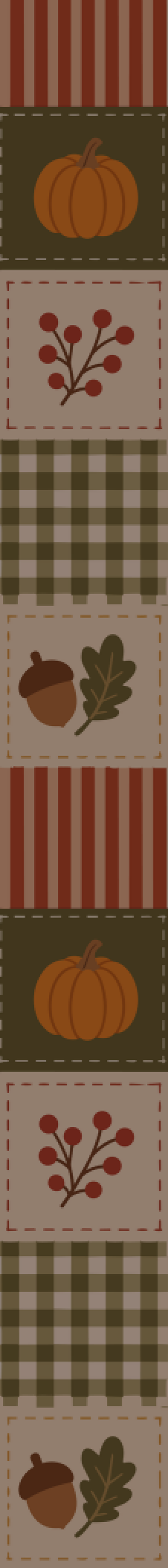

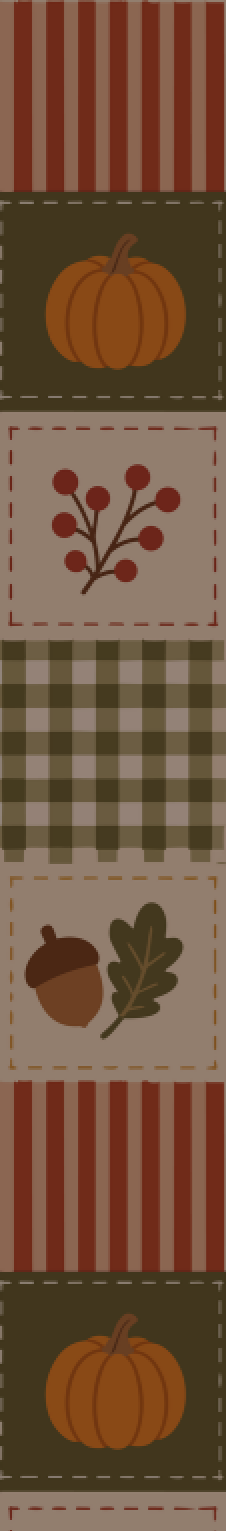
