



Membership activities are obtainable through invitation or application and may be temporary or permanent. The clubs are easily reached from any part of the lake region by automobile or boat.




New Wonders Are Found Each Day on Horseback

The boys' and girls' camps are enthusiastic over this sport, for they are able to go to points of vantage where it would be impossible to reach by either automobile or on foot.




It's a Land for Sport and Play

Lake trout, salmon, bass and other fresh water fish bite well in season.

Guides may be obtained at reasonable rates and they will often save much time for the fisherman whose stay is limited and who wishes to go home with a good catch. Accommodations may be secured at any time of the year.

Hunters will find deer, bear, wildcat, fox, coon and other game. And the lake and its wooded surroundings are a natural place for birds of all kinds.

**An Ideal Spot for Boys' and Girls' Camps**






When Winter Comes, One Finds Exhilarating Sport

Many carnivals are held, and during this season, special rates and service are given by the railroad so that guests may come quickly and comfortably.


Through Pullman train service from the larger cities, comfortable hotels and boarding places are offered those who would enjoy the great white out-of-doors.



The lake region attracts thousands to enjoy the sports of winter.




**Waterfalls and Streams of Rare Beauty**


Thousands of dollars have been spent in developing magnificent estates. Men of wealth and position are finding in this region their ideal of summer vacation land for themselves and their families.

The natural splendor of surroundings and the enjoyment that is possible makes this region an ideal resting place.


*The Resorts of the Lake Region*

Many Interesting Trips Into the Mountains




New Hampshire is maintaining thousands of miles of well kept roads, which offer the motorist untold delight and many hours of pleasant riding.



The owner of a motor car, or those who make their trips in public conveyances will find the lake region a spot which will offer truly a motorist's paradise.





Where One Will Find Every Comfort, Every Convenience

**T**HE hotels, the stopping places in and about the lake region have often been the subject of much favorable comment.


Located conveniently to golf courses, churches and the centers of attraction, one finds hotels which are most modern, and where every convenience may be had.

Many small hotels—where one may enjoy homelike surroundings.




**You'll Want to Come Again**

From the Grand Central Station, New York, through sleeper and Pullman service.  
Through trains from Boston to Montreal pass through this district.

### GOOD ROADS

From BOSTON, via Lowell, Nashua, follow the Daniel Webster State Highway to the lake region, distance 110 miles, macadam road.  
From BOSTON, via Newburyport Turnpike, Portsmouth, Dover, Rochester, Sanbornville, to the lake region. Distance 115 miles.  
From NEW YORK and all other points South to Lowell, Mass., Nashua, follow the Daniel Webster Highway.


## *An Invitation*
