NONAPPROPRIATED FUNDS

The Trustees of the Library are authorized to receive non-appropriated funds provided that such monies do not require the expenditure of other town funds. Non-appropriated funds are exempt from all provisions of RSA 32 relative to limitations and expenditure of Town monies, all as provided RSA 202-A:4-c. (Article 12, 1992)

Monies are received from the following sources:

- 1. Gifts (including requests from the Friends of the Library).
- 2. Copier, printers, and fax.
- 3. Grants.
- 4. Interest.
- 5. Fees.
- 6. Trust fund income.
- 7. Maps and other products the library may decide to sell.
- 8. Fines. All monies received from fines are used for general repairs and upgrading, and for the purchase of books, supplies and income-generating equipment in accordance with RSA 202-A:11-III.
- 9. Passports.
- 10. The Town of Gilford for reimbursement of expenses that have been paid directly by the library but were appropriated.

Receipts and expenses shall be reported for Town Reports at the conclusion of each fiscal year and audited annually.
