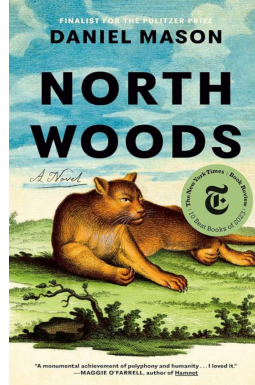
David Stamps has been a volunteer for about six months now.

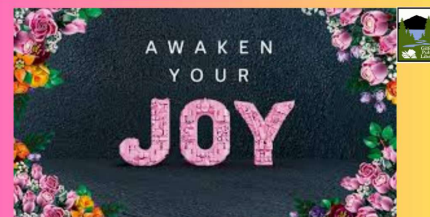
- April 16 @ 5:30PM: *Book Discussion - North Woods* by Daniel Mason. Led by Betty; books available at the front desk.
